

NORTH WEST BIO-ENERGY LTD. COMMISSIONING CONTINUES!



Another important milestone was attained on July 20, 2009 at the North West Bio-Energy (NWB) ethanol facility as commissioning of the mill took place. The mill is an integral part of the ethanol plant as it grinds the wheat into flour before it enters the process. The mill has a maximum capacity of approximately 12 tonnes per hour (440 bushels per hour). One of the unique features of the mill is that it is a disc type mill. NWB chose a disc type mill over a more traditional hammer type mill because of its quieter and more efficient operation.

Wet commissioning is nearing completion and the ethanol facility is currently on schedule to begin making its first ethanol on August 4, 2009.
