NWT POSTS POSITIVE FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR FIRST 6 MONTHS

The Board of Directors of North West Terminal Ltd. (NWT) is pleased to report positive earnings for the company after its first six months of operation in 2007-08. For the period beginning November 1, 2007 and ending April 30, 2008, NWT posted revenues from grain handling of \$45.6 million and an EBITDA of \$1,378,934 (unaudited). This resulted in net income of \$695,528 or \$0.21 per share. NWT shares last traded at \$3.50 on its OTC market with UNION SECURITIES LTD. @ www.saskstocklist.com.

The financial performance of the company is in line with the same period last year when the company posted revenues from grain handling of \$28.3 million, an EBITDA of \$1,576,943 and a net income of \$708,852 or \$0.22 per share. Management reported that grain shipments were similar to the previous year.

“The Board is very pleased with these results” says NWT’s President Jim Skinner. “We are currently in a period of significant growth for the company with the addition of many new shareholders and the construction of the fuel-ethanol plant underway. We are grateful to our customers and shareholders for their continued support,” Skinner farms near Wilkie, Saskatchewan.

NWT continues to move forward with the construction of a 25 million litre per year fuel-ethanol facility at Unity, Saskatchewan. The total cost of the project is expected to be \$42 million. Provided that construction continues to proceed according to schedule, the facility will start producing ethanol in the fall of 2008.

North West Terminal Ltd. is a farmer-shareholder owned grain terminal located east of Unity, Saskatchewan in the North West region of the Province.
