### **NWT COMPLETES DRIVEWAY UPGRADE**

The Board of Directors of North West Terminal Ltd. (NWT) is pleased to announce that construction is complete on an upgrade to the Company's grain-receiving capacity at its Unity, Saskatchewan location. The Company has expanded its grain receiving system to include a second platform scale with a capacity of approximately 400 tonnes (15,000 bushels) per hour.

The project increases the speed at which the Company can receive deliveries from its farmer-customers by as much as 25 per cent through greater efficiency and flexibility. The total cost of the project was just over \$867,000 and was financed using existing capital.

"The Board of Directors is very pleased with the upgrade to the delivery system," says NWT's President Brad Sperle. "As I said when we announced this project, we strive to be an industry leader in everything we do as a business. This expansion allows us to better serve our farmer-customers by improving truck unloading speeds and eliminating lineups." Sperle farms near Unity, Saskatchewan.

NWT is an independent farmer-shareholder owned company headquartered near Unity, Saskatchewan in the North West region of the province. NWT owns and operates both an inland-grain terminal and a bio-products manufacturing facility at its Unity location. NWT is also a minority owner of Alliance Seed Corp. (ASC) in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan and Alliance Grain Terminal Ltd. (AGT) in Vancouver, British Columbia.
